**Date:** 21/06/2020

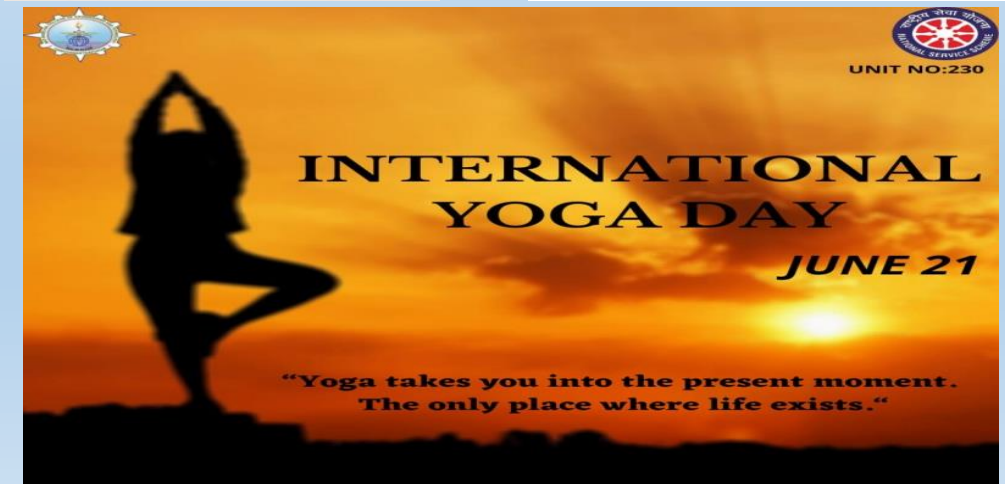
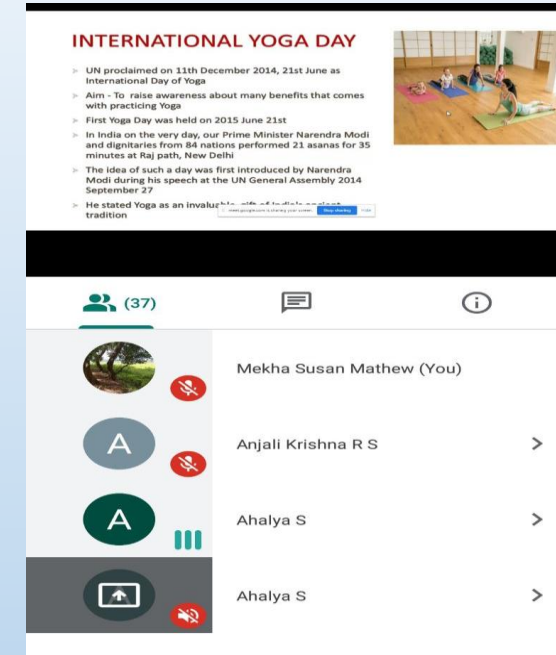
**Venue:** Online (Google Meet)

# WORLD DRUG DAY

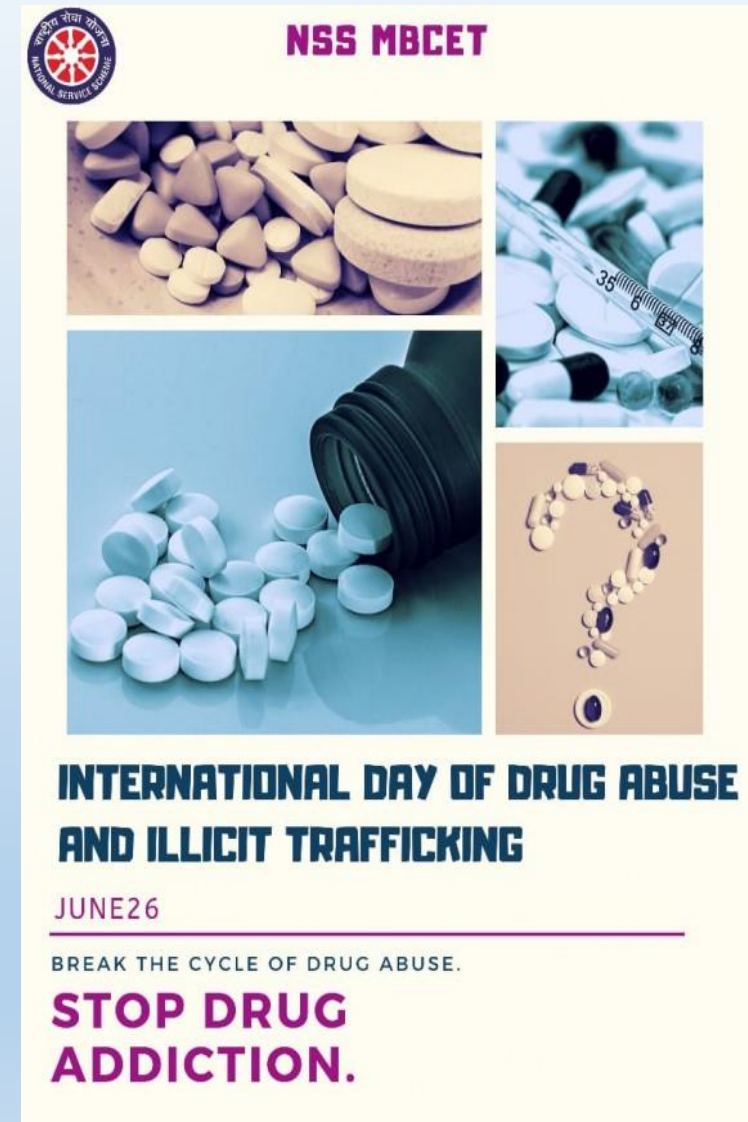
**Date:** 26/06/2020

# NSS AWARENESS QUIZ FOR VOLUNTEER SELECTION


**Date:** 05/07/2020

# MONTHLY MEETING

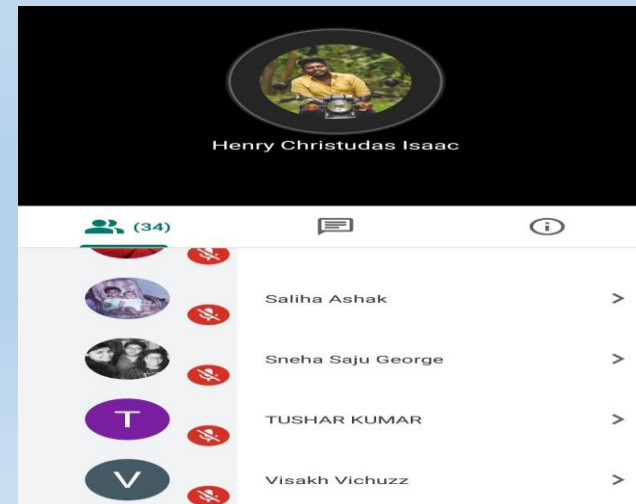
**Date:** 06/07/2020

**Date:** 13/04/2020

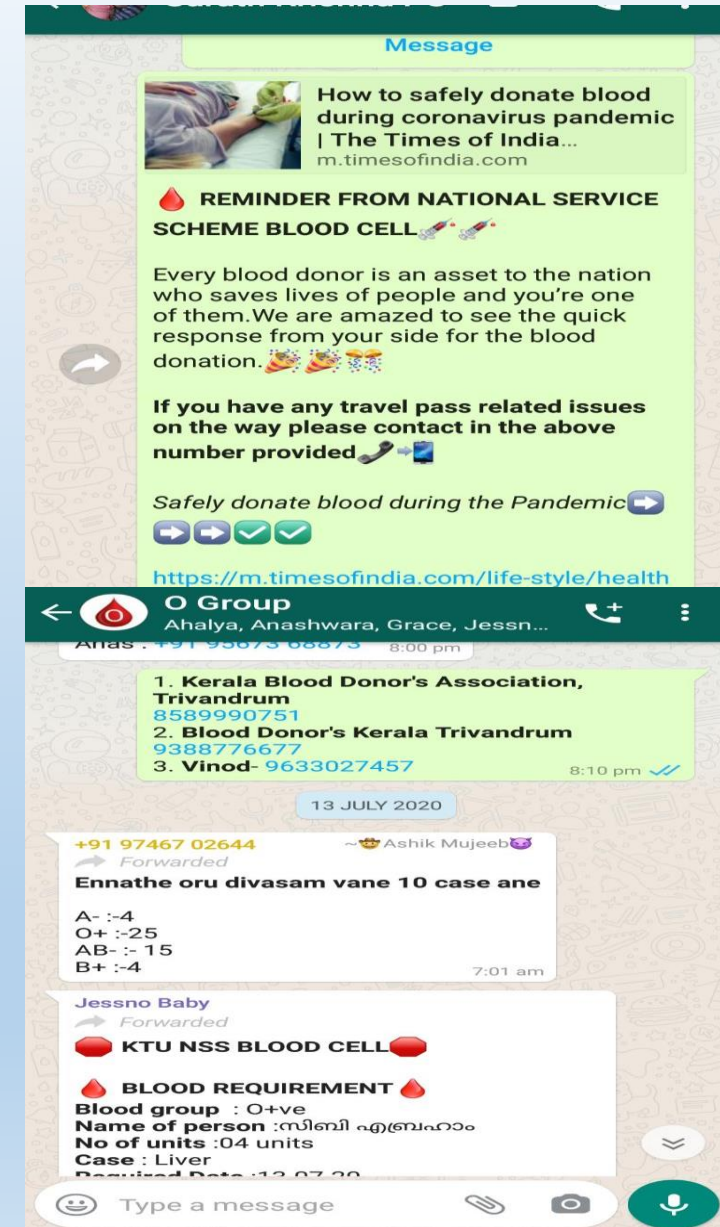
**Venue:** Trivandrum (Assigned duties were completed online)

**Outcomes:** July 13, 2020 was the first duty day of NSS blood cell activities for NSS unit 230. The volunteers were grouped based on their respective blood groups.

Different cases were assigned to us at around 9 am. The given cases were verified by contacting the bystanders. Due to the prevailing triple lockdown situation in Trivandrum, the task for finding and convincing the donors was not an easy task.

**Highlights:** By the end of the day, 10 cases were closed, finding about 41 donors. Travel pass was made available for the required donors and the awareness regarding 'safe donation of blood during the pandemic' was also done. The day gave us a really great experience and we felt the happiness of being a lifesaver of someone.
