WORLD BOOK DAY

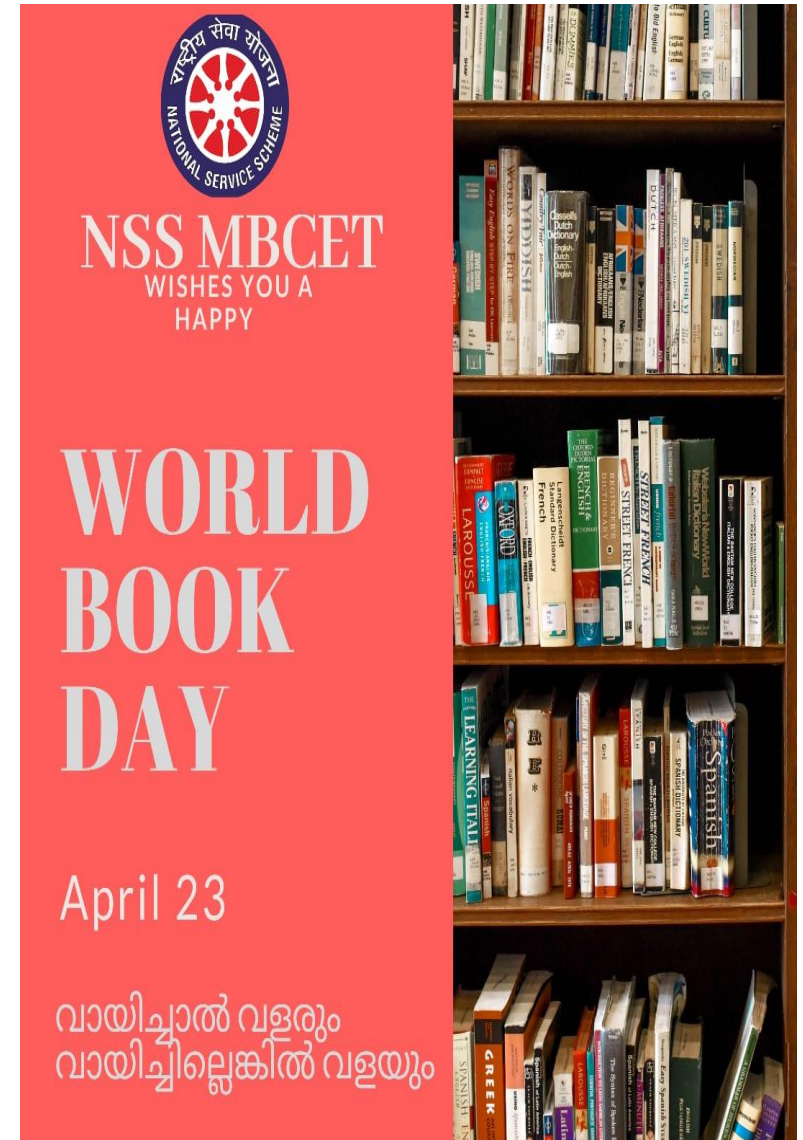

INTERNATIONAL DANCE DAY

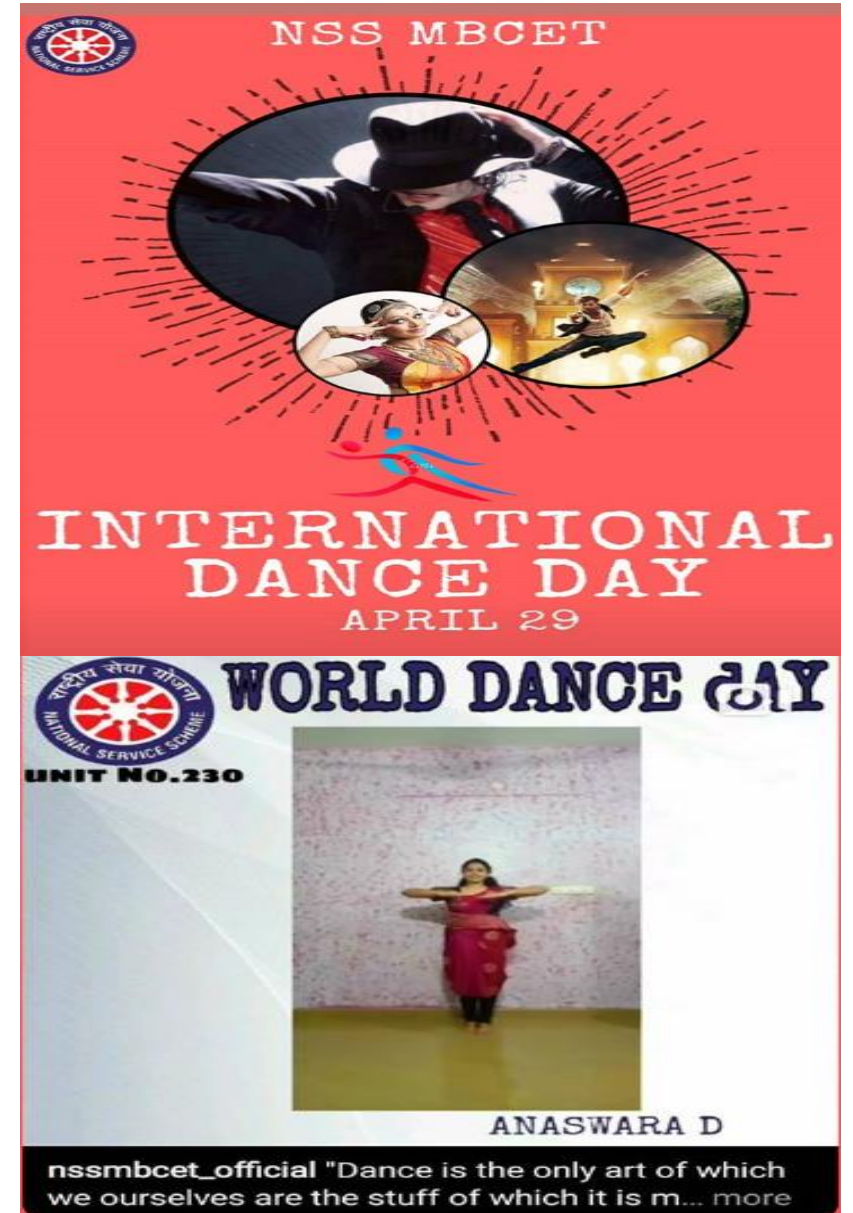

WORLD LABOUR DAY

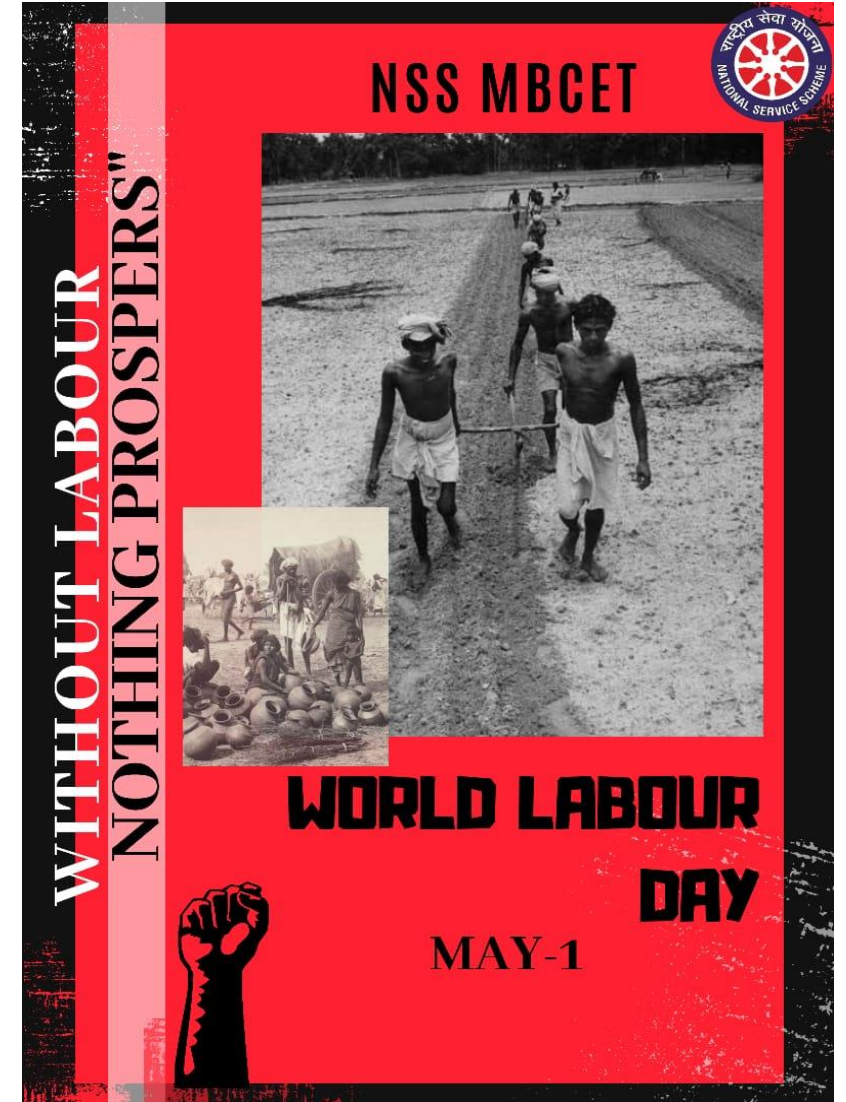
