Expert on Disruptive Tehnology Excerpts from interview with Dr. Venkataraman Balaji, President TVS

Q: How would the disruptive technologies influence and transform strategic, tactical and operational decision making in manufacturing sector?

Ans: Let us take the example of IoT — Both process flow and information flow get concurrent, thereby quality of decisions get far better. We are shrinking the PDCA cycle, making the decision making process more justifiable, scientific than just gut. The cause & effect could be identified with ease, the problems could be spotted at the origins

itself thereby eliminating the rejections & work, improving the effectiveness. This could be used for monitoring (tactical) or actuation(strategic). AI and ML would complement the decision making process moving continuously better and better. For a shop floor manager, it immensely helps in taking wiser decisions with justifications.


AUTOMATA ACTIVITY
