Roof Top Solar Power Plant



The first Solar Power Plant with a capacity of 100 kWp was commissioned in April 2013, and the second one of 100 kWp in August 2018. The total project outlay was approximately Rs.267.00 Lakhs. Currently, the power is fed to the grid during off-load times and holidays. It is observed that the Utility's bill amount is remaining without much increase in spite of the increased usage of electricity on the campus. The significance of the venture can

be understood if we look at the carbon footprint caused by the conventional methods of electricity generation. One unit of electricity generated through thermal generation may cause the emission of 450 grams of carbon dioxide (CO2) (https://www.eia.gov). Our power plant has helped in reducing the CO2 emission by 6.75 tons in a single month. Our plant is installed and maintained by M/s Radiant Solar Pvt. Ltd, Plot No. 15 Fab City, SEZ- Hyderabad. The scheme was supported under the Solar Mission of the Government of India through the Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (https://mnre.gov.in/).
