The set up consists of the following: a) Three oil cooled cascaded transformers of 70 kV, 100mA. b) with motorized panel transformer. This test kit works on a voltage 50Hz. at The high voltage transformer is the key part of the equipment. This is a two stage cascaded transformer. The experiments conducted with this High voltage test kit are: i) Calibration of high voltage meters ii) Measurement of dielectric strength iii) String efficiency of suspension insulators iv) One minute dry withstand test on insulators.
