
## ASCE ACTIVITIES 2021-22






#### ASCE NATIONAL CONFERENCE 2021






#### WORLD HERITAGE DAY QUIZ








## FAREWELL FOR FACULTY ADVISOR

programme really memorable. The meeting ended with welcoming the new Co-advisor of the Chapter, Ms. Anupama Krishnan D.





## TALK ON BASICS OF URBAN STREET DESIGN AND BENGALURU CITY INITIATIVES






#### ABOUT NOTION


## MASTERS ABROAD






#### IAS PATHWAYS







#### STOCK MARKET




# QGIS WORKSHOP
