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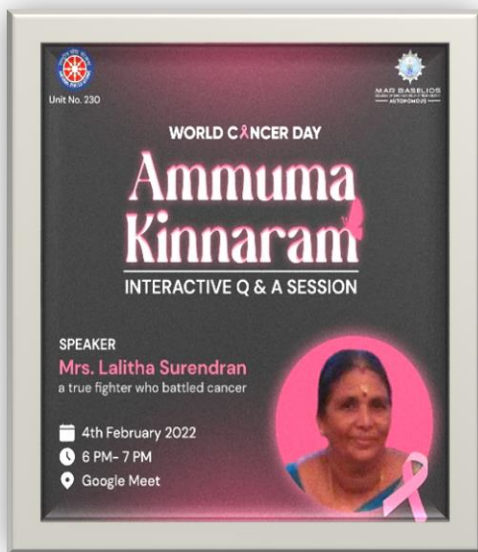
SUMMARY

NSS Unit 230 started its voyage in 2010. From then, we have been conducting various awareness and social service programmes, webinars, etc. Our college, Mar Baselios College of Engineering and Technology, our programme officers. Mr Rejish Babu F. R. and Ms. A. V. Soumya, and other faculty members have provided support and resources for conducting these services.

The 2022 batch of Unit 230 has organised various events, including the flash mob for World Environment Day, interactive session with a cancer survivor for World Cancer Day, and a rally to promote clean energy, to raise awareness. The Unit has also distributed kits of food items to economically backward families for Onam. A faculty orientation for programme officers of the Southern region of the state was a major event. These events and more provide a service to our community.

1. AMMUMA KINNARARM

As a part of World Cancer Day, NSS unit 230 of Mar Baselios College of Engineering and Technology conducted, an online interactive session with Mrs. Lalitha Surendran, a true fighter who battled cancer, on 4th February of 2022. Through this interactive session, our volunteers and students from college got a clear image of the suffering of the affected persons and their physical and mental state. The students clarified their doubts regarding the social stigmas that prevails in society, and about the real situations they have to face. Mrs Lalitha shared her experience and motivations to keep fighting even at her age. The session was monitored by our volunteer Ms. Meghana, who happened to be the granddaughter of Mrs Lalitha, and the session was organised by Ms. Rachana, our volunteer. The session steered the view of the volunteers towards the patients.



2. NSS ENVIRONMENT DAY MIME/FLASHMOB

June 5th is celebrated as World Environment Day every year throughout the country. Its objective is to provide maximum awareness about the importance of environment. As a part of this awareness program, our NSS volunteers conducted a flash mob and mime. It was conducted at Lulu Mall, Trivandrum on 12th of June. At the end of the program, we conducted a quiz based on World Environment Day with the audience as contestants. The winners are rewarded with a plant.





3. FIRE EXTINGUISHER WORKING TRAINING

The Program officer Rejish sir and the Staff members of MBCET conducted a fire extinguisher working training session for NSS Volunteers. The session is all about the effective use of the fire extinguisher at the time of need. The Staff members demonstrated the procedure, and all the volunteers take part in it. The Session was very interesting. It was conducted on 21st of June.



4. CLEAN ENERGY CHALLENGE RALLY

Government of Kerala, Kerala Development and Innovation Strategic Council (KDISC), Kerala State Electricity Board (KSEB), Clean Energy Innovation & BUSINESS Incubation Centre (CEIBIC), National service scheme (NSS) of State organisation collaboratively conducted a challenge regarding state energy conservation. 6. ORIENTATION PROGRAMME FOR NSS PROGRAM OFFICERS

For the enhancement of the NSS programme officers a 3-day orientation was conducted by NSS unit 230 in Mar Baselios Engineering college sponsored by KTU. The Programme was inaugurated on 10.08.2022 by NSS state coordinator Dr. Joy Varghese V.M accompanied by the Principal and the Bursar of the college and the NSS program officer Rejish Sir. The main initiatives for the fund collection were conducted by NSS unit, ACE (Dept of Computer Science), CESA (Dept of Civil Engineering Science), ILLUMINA (Dept of Electrical and Electronics), E-NIX (Dept of Electronics and Communication), and SPANDANAM (Dept of Mechanical Engineering), and funds were collected from students across various departments. In total, 112 kits were distributed to 112 families from Kallayam, Thiruvananthapuram.



9. PROJECT GANITHAM INTRODUCTIVE SESSION
