1. OBJECTIVES

The policy is prepared with the objective of:

- 1.2 Achieving integrated Waste Management reporting and planning.
- 1.3 Ensure segregation of Waste at the source
- 1.4 Treating and safely disposing of Waste as a last resort.
- 1.5 Increase consumer awareness of Waste minimization issues
- 1.6 Ensure the protection of the environment through effective Waste Management measures.
- 1.7 Encourage Waste to Energy options through projects and research work
- 1.8 Carry out regular internal Waste Managing Audits to continuous monitoring and assessments of various Waste management systems in the college.
- 1.9 Regular monitoring and follow up procedures managed by the Institution Waste Management Cell for effective implementation at department levels.
- 1.10 Educate the stakeholders through awareness campaigns, and clean up drives, to make the Institute a role model of Efficient Waste Management System.
- 1.11 Promote Collaborations with Govt. Bodies / Industries / NGOs to promote sustainable practices in the Campus

3. POLICY STATEMENT

4. RESPONSIBILITY

The Waste Management Team ensures the smooth functioning of the Waste Management strategies in the college. The team is headed by:

- (i) Bursar
- (ii) Principal
- (iii) NAAC Coordinators, Criteria 7 Members
- (iv) Waste Management Cell Members

The Waste Management Cell (WMC) is in charge of ensuring the proper execution and monitoring of the Waste Management system in the college. The cell comprises of:

- (i) Waste Management Cell Coordinator and Faculty Representatives from all Departments
- (ii) One Technical Staff member from each Department
- (iii) Housekeeping Staff Coordinator

The WMC ensures the Waste management system functions through:

1. Regular Monitoring and benchmarking resource use and Waste generation.
2. Quantifying, Monitoring and Evaluating the Waste generation, disposal and collection system in the Campus, regularly.
3. Setting short term and long term targets and conservation strategies pertaining to the UN Sustainable Goals.
4. Collaboration with government bodies such as State Pollution Control Board for auditing and Suchitwa Mission, the Technical Support Group (TSG) in Waste Management sector under the Local Self Government Department, Government of Kerala for awareness campaigns
