<b>Discussions</b>	<p>Chairman informed the BoS to make a note on the approval obtained from AICTE for the conduct new UG course - B.Tech in "Computer Science and Engineering(Artificial Intelligence)".</p> <p>The Chairman presented the curriculum and syllabi of the Courses to be offered by the Department for the First Year level for B.Tech in CSE(AI) for approval.</p> <p>The BoS inspected the proposed Syllabus and gave the following comments:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Swap Operating System and Operating System Lab in fourth semester with Artificial Intelligence and Artificial Intelligence lab in fifth semester since the course Computer Organization and Architecture is the prerequisite of Operating System.</li> <li>2. In sixth semester, the course Compiler Design can be made as elective course and Artificial Neural Networks as core course.</li> <li>3. Change the elective course Advanced Concepts of Microprocessor and Microcontroller in seventh semester with courses like AI using hardware.</li> <li>4. Include more AI specific electives.</li> <li>5. Add more subjects in AI specific domains and remove system level subjects.</li> </ol>




	<p>6. The minor course Client Server Systems can be replaced with some good subject in networking domain.</p> <p>7. The syllabus of all the courses is in par with other universities.</p> <p>8. Curriculum is missing Networks Lab. Suggested to include Computer Systems Lab in fifth semester with Part A : Operating System and Part B: Networks.</p>
<b>Decision of the body</b>	<p>Chairman welcomed the suggestions by the external experts and informed that it can be included after a department level discussion.</p> <p>BoS approved the first-year syllabi of the courses of B.Tech in CSE(AI) with minor changes.</p>

The course C Programming introduced exclusively for CSE students.</li> <li>3. Chairman highlighted the proposed changes in the new curriculum and the courses which are added/removed/combined.</li> </ol>
<b>Decision of the body</b>	BoS approved the revised curriculum with minor changes.
