Decision

The Chairman apprised the BoS about a student Ms. Aswathy S. (M.Tech. Structural Engineering) who had discontinued her studies under KTU from this college in the year 2018. She has now rejoined for M.Tech. Structural Engineering under the Autonomy 2020 scheme and is now in the 4th semester. She had failed in three courses listed below during her 1st semester (examinations were conducted by KTU). Hence supplementary examinations are to be conducted for these three courses under the Autonomy 2020 scheme.

- 1. Structural Dynamics,
- 2. Theory of Elasticity and
- 3. Experimental Methods and Instrumentation

The 1st and 2nd course is being offered under the 2020 scheme with variations in course contents less than 20% with respect to the courses she had registered earlier under KTU.

Regarding the 3rd course, an entirely new course named Behaviour of Structural Methods and Instrumentation has been introduced in the 2020 scheme for Structural Engineering. Hence the marks secured by her for the internal assessments in Course 1 and 2 could be considered now whereas an instruction/clarity is required from KTU regarding the internal assessment marks for Course 3.

The members of BoS has suggested to go ahead with conducting the supplementary exams for the 1st and 2nd course. Whereas for the 3rd course necessary instructions need to be obtained from KTU.
