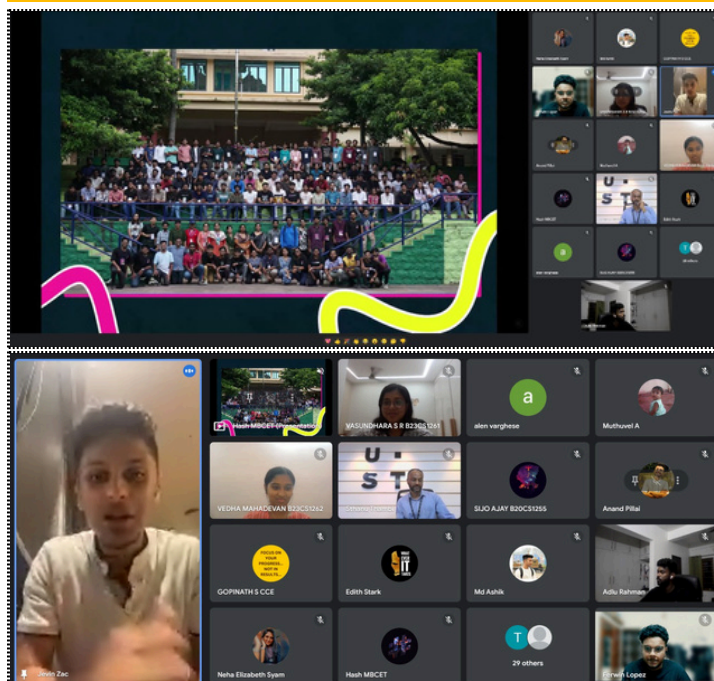




DEFINE HACKATHON- 2024: WINNERS
