WHAT ARE ACADEMIC BANK OF CREDITS (ABC)?

- ABC/ Automated Permanent Academic Account Registry (APAAR) is a <u>digital identification system for all students in</u> India.
- Every student in India is required to register for APAAR/ABC ID - a unique 12-digit code.
- This is used to digitally store, manage, and access all their academic credits, including degrees, diplomas, certificates, training details, and co-curricular accomplishments.
- It helps the students for easily transfer from one institute to another or to resume their studies if they choose to leave their courses for a while.


How are credits counted and accumulated?

- Each course has a number of credits assigned to it.
- The student must achieve the specified number of credits given in the course.
- 1 credit is equivalent to 15 hours of theory learning in class for a duration of semester.
- 1 credit is equivalent to 30 hours practical work in labs for a duration of semester.
- Credits can also be earned through seminar and paper presentation, group work, assignments, class tests, examinations, community work, field trips, and other academic activities.
- Credits are thus based on Attendance and Participation in the academic activities.

ABC Benefits

- The idea is to **"remove rigid boundaries and create new possibilities"** for students to choose and learn the subjects of their choice.
- ABC brings a creative combination of disciplines for study with multiple entries and exit points.
- \circ Only verified academic institutions can upload credits.
- Improves transparency and helps to build a more flexible approach to curriculum design and development.
- $\circ~$ Stores student credit for a shelf life of 7 years.
- Transfer credit through a single window after approval of source and destination academic institution.
- Increases the student's freedom in choosing their courses & academics.
- Enables the student to drop out in any year and then exchange the credits earned so far with a certificate/diploma if they are eligible.
- They can redeem the credits and rejoin the same or any other institute in the future and continue their education.
- \circ The institutes cannot keep the students in the courses against their will.
- It will provide the opportunity for students to tailor their degrees or make specific modifications or specializations rather than undergoing the rigid, regularly prescribed degree or courses of a single university or autonomous college.

Current Strategies of ABC implementation

- Sensitizing students & Faculty Members through Campaigns, Training & Workshops.
- Students ABC ID Creation
- Mandate ABC ID for various forms like Admission & Examination forms to Upload credit score with ABC ID.
- Inform Students to fetch digital certificates and check credits accumulated in Students ABC accounts.

HOW TO CREATE AN ABC ID?

- AADHAR NUMBER AND MOBILE NUMBER LINKED TO AADHAR NUMBER ARE COMPULSORY
- DIGILOCKER ACCOUNT IS COMPULSORY
- DIGILOCKER is a digitization service provided by the Government of India.
- DigiLocker allows access to digital versions of various documents including driver's licenses, vehicle registration certificates and academic mark sheets which are equivalent to hard copies of the same.
- It also provides 1 GB storage space to each account to upload scanned copies of their documents.

Academic Bank of Credits has been established on the lines of the National Academic Depository (NAD), in the sense, NAD is the backbone of ABC, where the students' academic data are held and academic awards are stored (i.e. storehouse of academic awards). Despite the fact that ABC enables students to register or commence credit transfer, the final outcomes of credit redemption and issuance of certificates, as well as the compilation of award records, are administered by academic institutions via the NAD Platform. Hence being the owner of academic awards. Academic Institutions must mandatorily register themselves under ABC via NAD



Common FAQs

Q1. Is there any regulation related to ABC?

A1. Yes, UGC has issued a regulation namely the University Grant Commission (Establishment and Operation of Academic Bank of Credits in Higher Education) Regulations, 2021.

Q2. Which institution can join ABC?

A2. All Universities in India established or incorporated by or under a Central Act, a Provincial Act or a State Act; the institutions Deemed-to be Universities declared as such under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 (3 of 1956); and the Autonomous Colleges as defined in these regulations and the Institutions of National-Importance as declared by the Government of India and specially empowered by an Act of Parliament to confer or grant degrees.

Q3. Which students can join ABC?

A3. All students who are affiliated to above mentioned institution.

Q4. How credits would be implemented?

A4. Registered Higher Education Institutions shall, with the approval of their statutory authorities, amend the extant Ordinances relating to acceptance for inter-disciplinary and multi-disciplinary courses, Credits to be offered to such courses, Credit transfers and Credits acceptance from other approved Higher Education Institutions, nature of grades to be awarded etc.

Q5. From which academic year the facility of ABC would be applicable?

A5. Credits obtained by undertaking Courses in Registered HEIs during or after the academic year 2021-2022 alone are eligible for Credit transfer, Credit accrual and credit redemption through academic bank of credits.

Q6. Can ABC award degree/diploma/certificate?

A6. No. ABC is a facility for credit accumulation transfer and redemption. Degree / Diploma / Certificate shall be awarded by the registered HEI.

Q7. What is Academic Bank Account?

A7. Academic Bank Account means an individual account with the Academic Bank of Credit opened and operated by a student, to which all academic credits earned by the student from course(s) of study are deposited, recognised, maintained, accumulated, transferred, validated or redeemed for the purposes of the award of degree / diploma / certificate etc by an awarding institution.

Q8. What is Credit accumulation?

A8. "Credit-accumulation" means the facility created by ABC in the Academic Bank Account opened by students in order to transfer and consolidate the credits earned by them by undergoing courses.

Q9. What is Credits-recognition?

A9. "Credits-recognition" means the credits earned through a registered Higher Educational Institution and transfer directly to the ABC by such HEIs.

Q10. What is Credits-transfer?

A10. "Credit-transfer" means the mechanism by which registered HEIs are able to receive or provide prescribed credits to individual Academic Bank Accounts in adherence to the UGC credit norms for the course undertaken by students enrolled in any registered HEIs within India.

Q11. What is Credits-Redemption?

A11. "Credit-redemption" means the process of commuting the accrued credits in the Academic Bank Accounts of the students maintained in ABC for the purpose of fulfilling the credits requirements for the award of Degrees or Diplomas or Certificates or course work for Ph.D. programs etc. by the registered degree awarding HEIs.

Q12. For how long will the ABC accumulated credits be available in the system?

A12. Credits deposited in the ABC platform will be valid for a maximum of seven years or the duration specified for a given discipline.
