





Canoe Discussion


Field Visit to Aruvikkara Water Treatment Plant



ASCE Talk Show on 'Trends in Civil Engineering & The Advancement of Technologies in Civil Engineering'



Energy Conservation Building Code (ECBC) & Eco Niwas Samhita (ENS) Awareness Program








Alumni Talk


