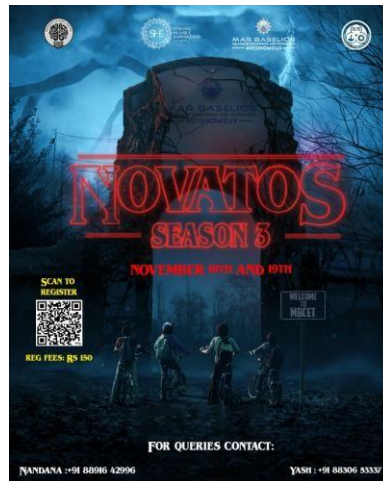
Children's Day

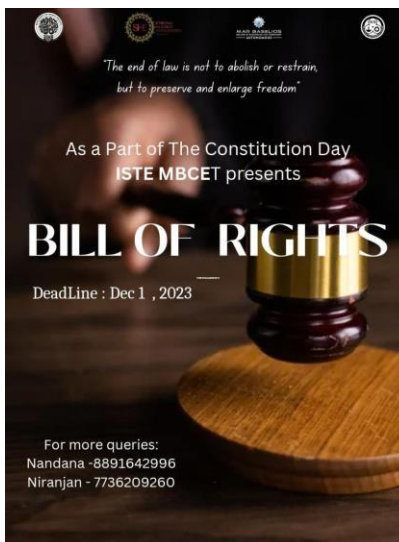
World Television Day

Men's Day

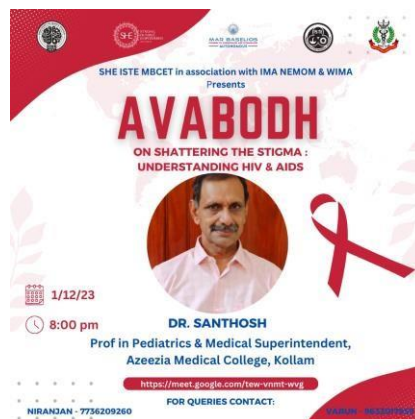

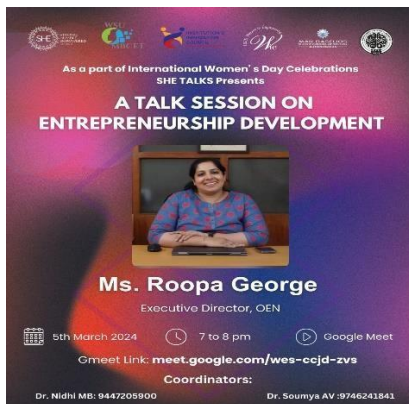
Junior Execom Selection

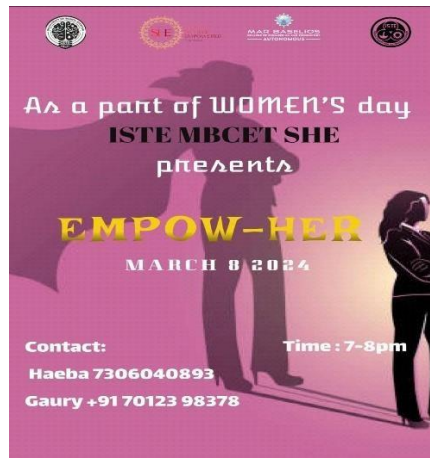
Women's Day

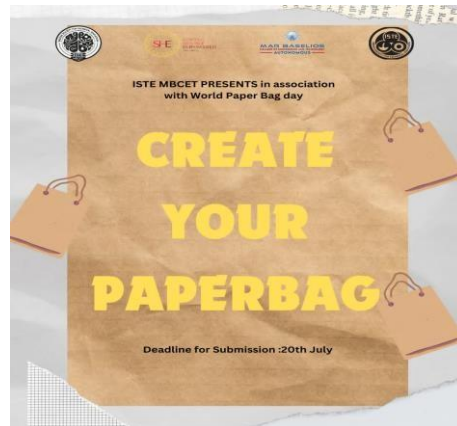
World Population Day Theme Submission

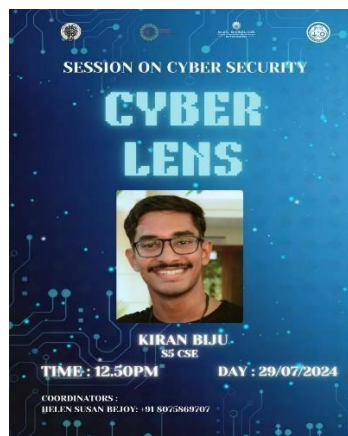
World Paper Bag Day

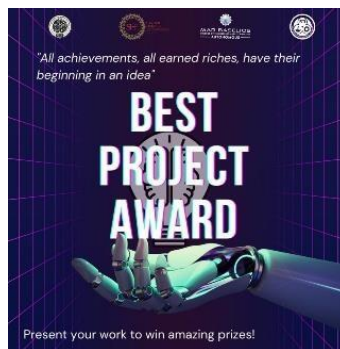
Olympics 2024 Prediction Challenge

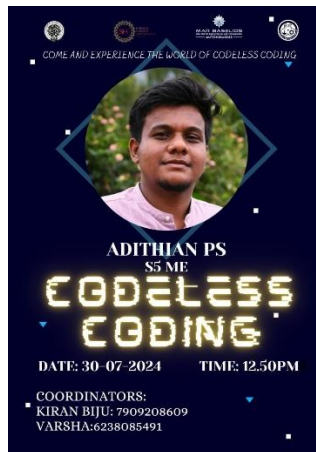
Best Project Award
