

• Dr. Jesna Mohan, Associate Professor, Department of CSE, attended a workshop for designing a




foundation module in Computer Science Engineering on 21.11.24, organized by K-DISC under Kerala Knowledge Economy Mission.




### SIGNIFY PLACEMENT DRIVE
