

STEPHEN HAWKING: THE GENIUS OF THIS CENTURY



Stephen Hawking (8 Jan 1942 - 14 March 2018), born in Oxford, after his graduation from Oxford, secured a Ph.D. from Cambridge. After teaching Gravitational Physics there in 1974, he was appointed to Cambridge's Lucasian Professorship of Mathematics, a post once held by Isaac Newton. In the 1960s, he contracted an incurable degenerative neuro-muscular disease called Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis, which made him a disabled person.

Major Works: A Brief History of Time, The Grand Design, Black Holes, and The Theory of Everything.

Indian Engineers Who Made Stephen Hawking Talk:

Dr. Arun Mehta and Vikram Crishna, Indian software engineers, developed the software 'e-locuter', enabling nonverbal disabled people to write and speak. Stephen Hawking spoke with the help of 'e-locuter.'



Final Message of Stephen Hawking to Humanity:

Before he departed us for worlds beyond, Stephen Hawking delivered the following final speech:"...I realized there is life; there is hope. There are many ambitious experiments planned for the future. We will map the positions of billions of galaxies. We will better understand our place in the universe. First, we must also continue to go into space for the future of humanity. I don't think we will survive another 1000 years without escaping beyond our fragile planet. It has been a glorious time to be alive doing research in theoretical physics. The fact that we humans, as collective fundamental particles of nature, have been able to come this close to an understanding of the laws governing us and our universe is a great triumph. I am happy if I have made a small contribution. I want to share my excitement and enthusiasm about this quest. So remember to look up at the stars and not down at your feet. Try to make sense of what you see and wonder about what makes the universe exist. Be curious, and however difficult life may seem, there is always something you can do and succeed at. It matters that you don't first give up. Well, there is life, there is hope."
