Proclaimed in 2011 by UNESCO Member States and adopted by the United Nations General Assembly in 2012 as International Day of the United Nations, February 13 became World Radio Day (WRD). The day is celebrated to acknowledge the contributions made by the radio professionals and volunteers all over the world.
