MUSIC COMPETITION


- On 18th September 2024, the MBCET student chapter of ASCE conducted a music competition in celebration of Onam

NEW YEAR FOOD DRIVE


- On 03rd January 2025, to celebrate the New Year, the MBCET ASCE student chapter organized a food drive to support those in need.
