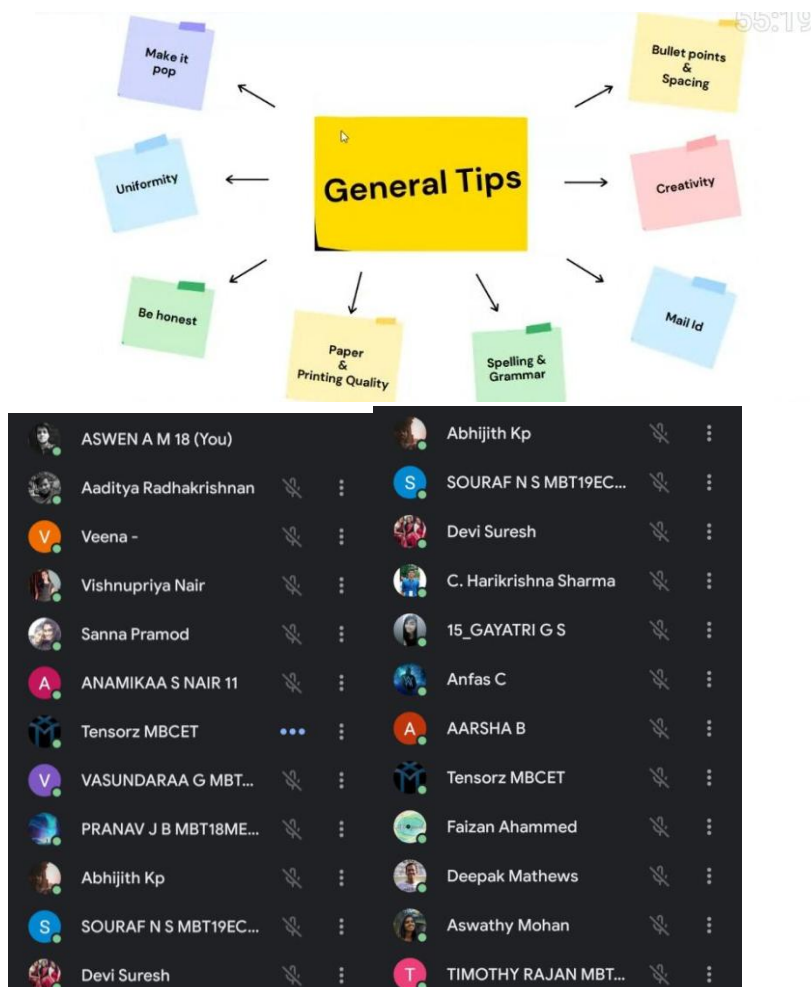
The knowledge gained at Tensorz will prepare them for interviews, inviting more opportunities and will help to find themselves in an easy position and soar to greater heights.

## EVENTS

### **1. Session on “How to make a Resume?” – 21<sup>st</sup> October 2020**

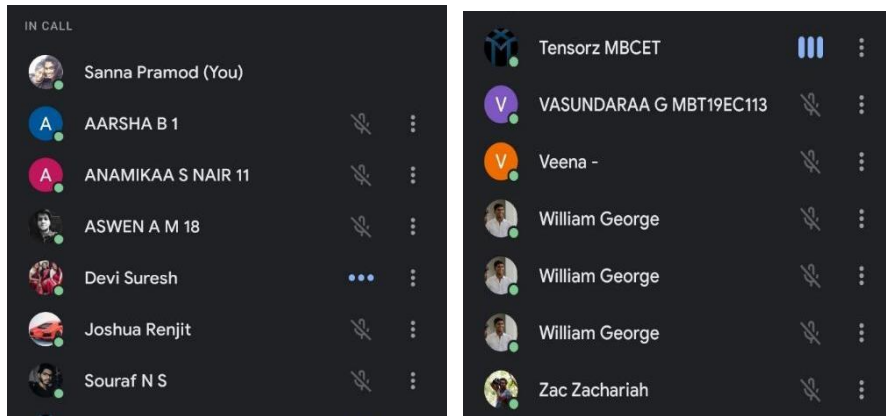


This session was hosted by Mr. William George, Co-founder of Tensorz, on, “How to make a Good Resume? “. He gave an insight on how to prepare an eye-catching resume with the help of general tips and all the key features to be included and also the most common errors to be avoided.

This session mainly focused on the design errors and helped the students identify them in a resume. He also provided the students with particulars and elucidated how pertinent it is to formulate a job specific resume.

By the end of the session, the participants were able to understand the importance of preparing a resume and how it has to be altered to suit their requirements. There were more than 15 enthusiastic participants.

### **2. Activity on Self-introduction – 10<sup>th</sup> November 2020**

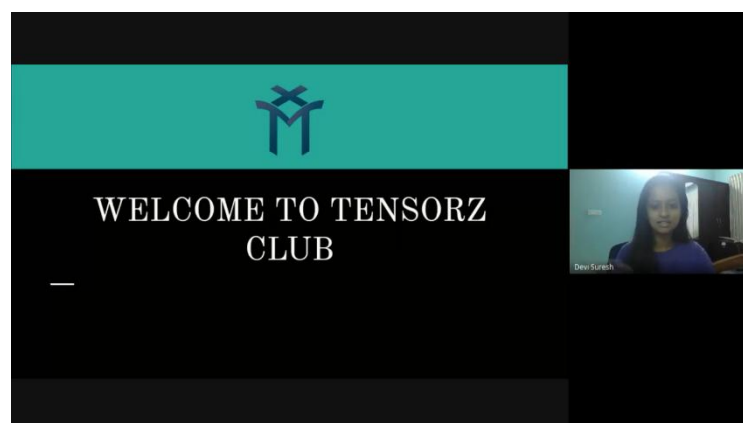


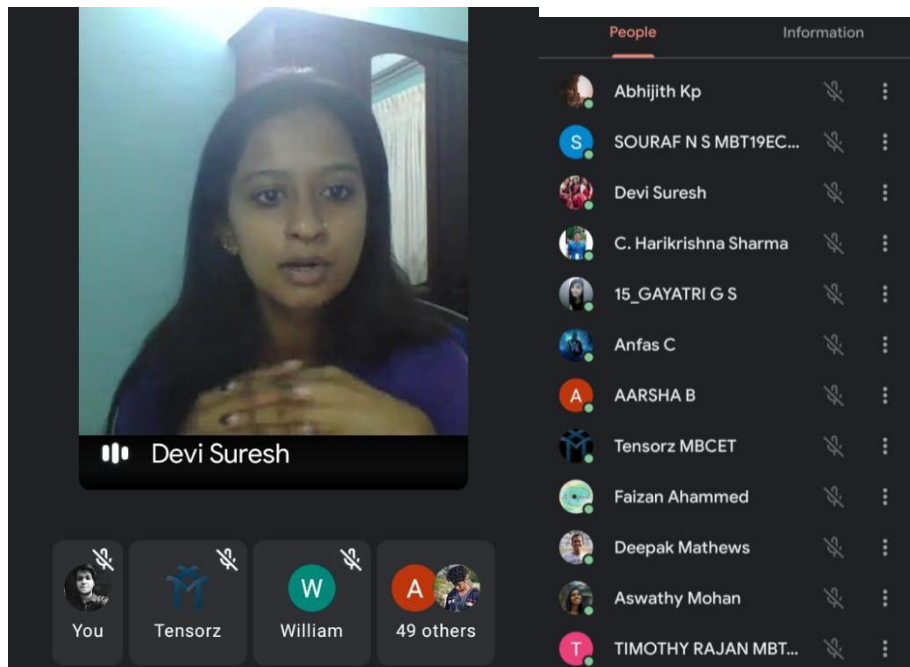

### **3. Session on “Formal Self-Introduction” – January 2<sup>nd</sup> 2021**



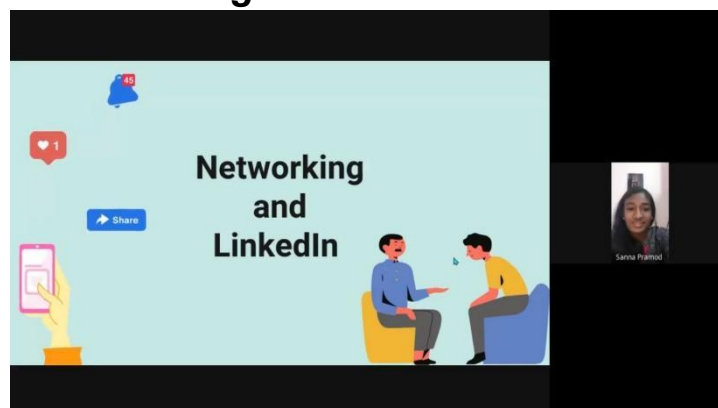


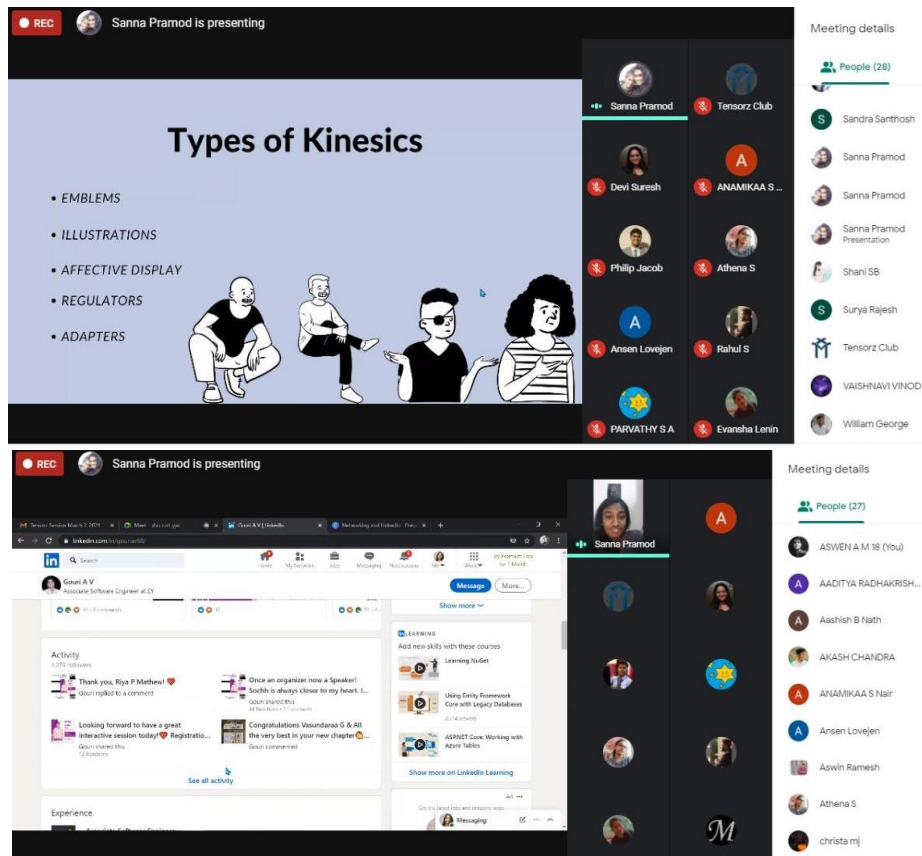

#### **4. Session on Networking and LinkedIn – March 2<sup>nd</sup> 2021**





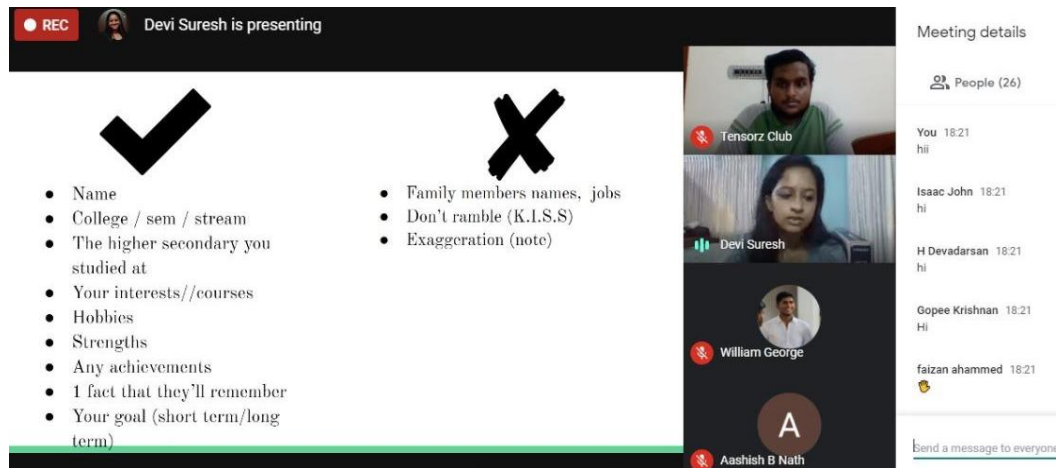

This was an interactive session and there were more than 30 interested participants. They cleared their queries regarding the usage of LinkedIn to enhance one's professional reputation and also about job opportunities on LinkedIn.

By the end of the session, the participants were able to understand the importance of kinesics in a professional environment, networking and also how LinkedIn focuses on professional networking.

## ***5. Session on Interviews – April 5<sup>th</sup> 2021***



The session on Interviews was handled by Aaditya Radhakrishnan and Devi Suresh (Co-founders of Tensorz). The session mainly focused on how various aspects have to be considered when you go for an interview, even minute details can act as barriers in the selection process.

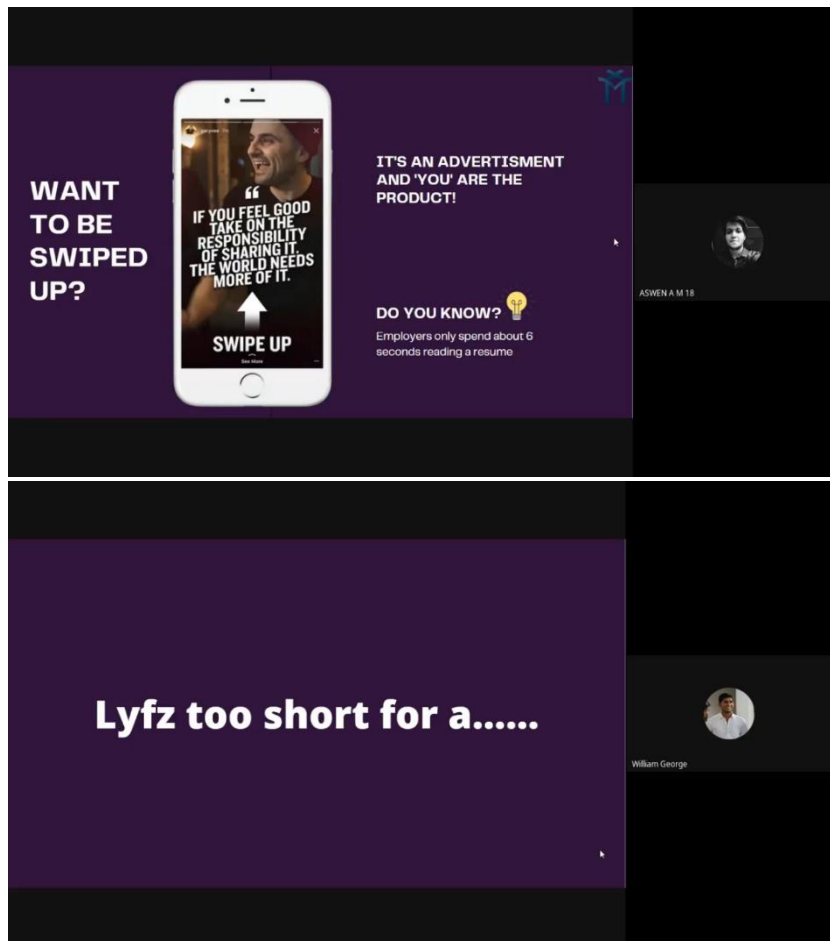

They also talked about the interview selection process which included aptitude test, coding test, group discussion and also about technical, HR and managerial interviews.

There were a total of more than 25 participants, who were enthusiastic and were actively giving answers to different questions.

By the end of the session all the participants learnt a great deal out of the session and learnt how to be a complete person when you go for an interview.

## **6. Session on Resume – 27<sup>th</sup> April 2021**



This repeated session was handled by William George, co-founder of Tensorz and Aswen AM, member of core team, on "Resume preparation". The session focused on the do's and don'ts of resume preparation and a guide to how to prepare one strong, to the point, crisp resume.

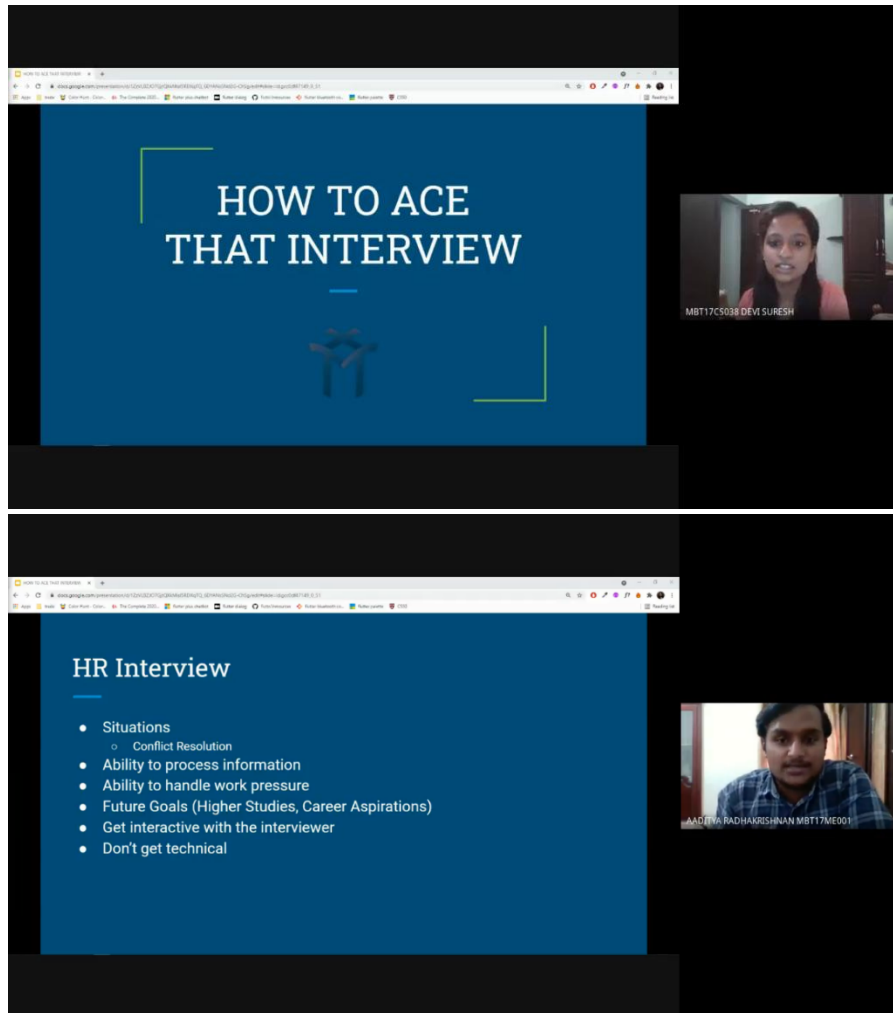

Aswen explained about structure and must haves of resume which was then followed up and wonderfully delivered by William, he discussed about his personal experience with his college application, about GitHub and some main topics covering the resume preparation.

## **7. Session on “How to ace that Interview?” – May 1<sup>st</sup> 2021**





This event was managed by Aaditya Radhakrishnan and Devi Suresh (Cofounders of Tensorz) on the topic. “How to ace that interview?” This was a repeated session for the students who missed the first session on interviews.

They discussed in detail about the various skills that has to be acquired in order to successfully ace technical and HR interviews. They also talked about the importance of communication skills and body language and also mentioned the S.T.A.R(Situation or Task, Action you took and Results you achieved) principle that can be used to proceed in an interview.

There were more than 20 active participants who benefitted from this session.

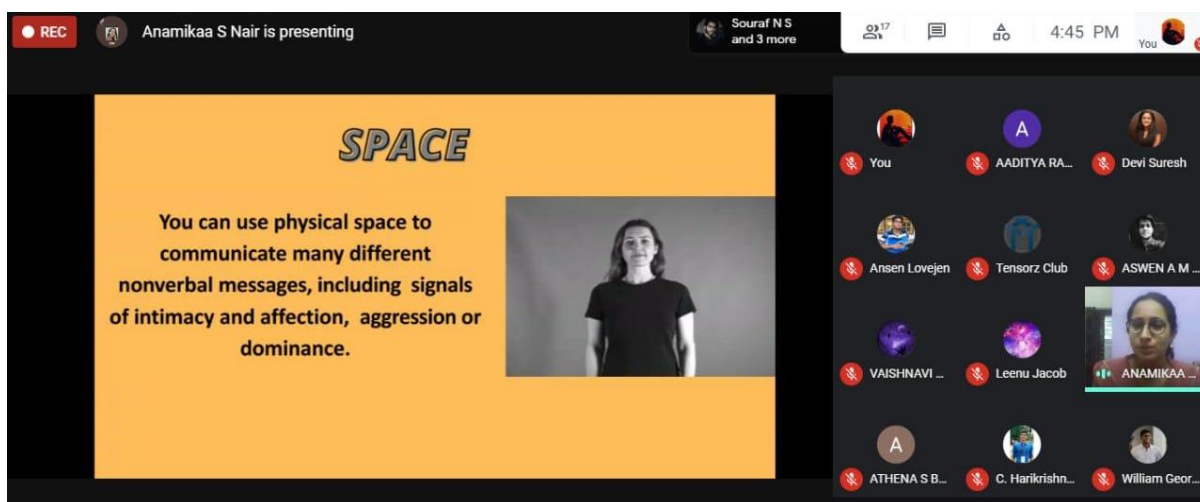
Faizan Ahamed has left the meeting

This session was organized by Faizan Ahamed, member of core team, S4 EC, who talked on the topic, "Verbal communication". In the first half of the session he elaborated about the pertinence of communication skills and also about the different types of communication.

He gave an insight on verbal communication and also went in-depth about familiar versus unfamiliar words, including connotative, denotative, abstract and concrete words. He also talked about the Lexi conic life cycle of words and also about word whiskers. It was an extremely informative and interactive session and was attended by more than 20 participants.

From this session, the students were able to comprehend and improve their verbal communication skills through practice.

## ***9. Session on Non-verbal communication – May 16<sup>th</sup> 2021***



Tensorz Club conducted a session on Non-verbal communication which was presided by Anamikaa S Nair, S4 EC. The main aim of the session was to inform all the students about the importance of using non-verbal communication in daily lives.

She elaborated about how more than 70% of the communication takes place through non-verbal means which involves eye communication, posture, gesture and many other factors. Non-verbal communication when used in correct way helps in building relationships by understanding the feelings or emotions of the other person.

This was an interactive session where students engaged with each other and elucidated their queries. She completed the session by citing examples and common mistakes a person makes while communicating non-verbally in a professional environment.

This session highlighted the importance of using good non-verbal communication while attending interviews, conferences and also while communicating with colleagues in a workspace. There were more than 18 participants who actively attended the session.

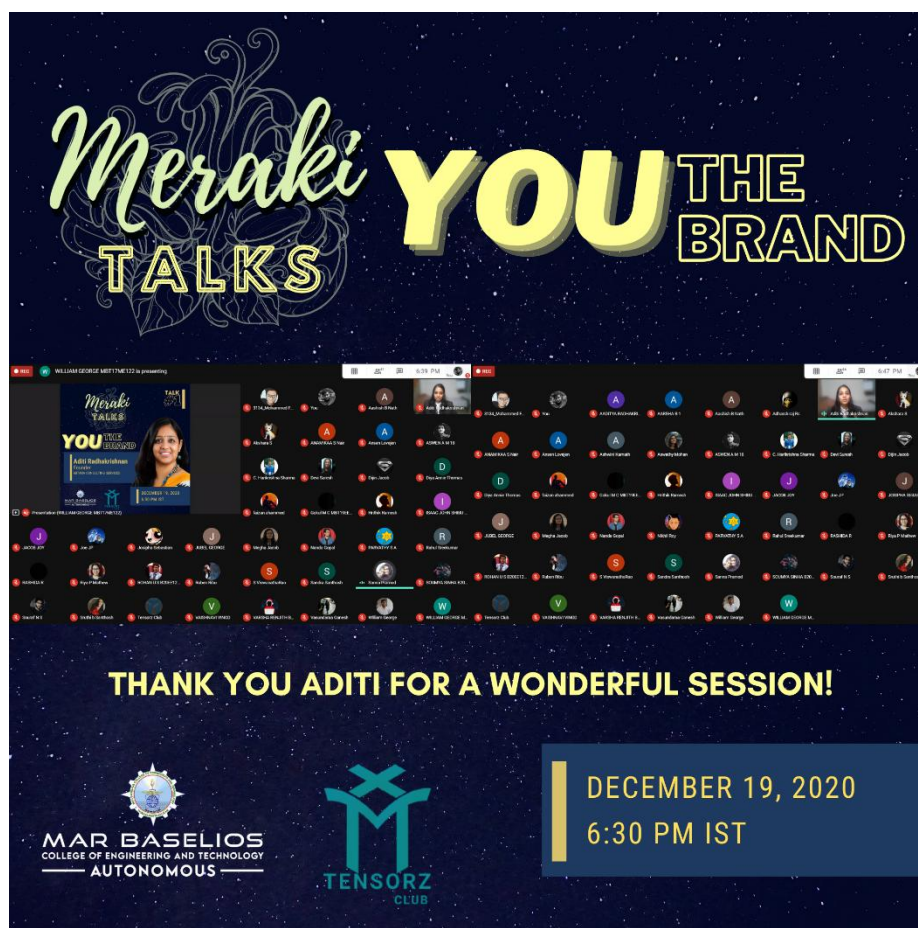

**1. Meraki Talk Series 1 – You:The Brand – Ms Aditi Radhakrishnan**

This session was handled by Ms. Aditi Radhakrishnan, Founder and Principal Consultant of Mitara Consulting Services, on, "You-The Brand ". Miss Radhakrishnan is running her own Strategy and Execution HR Consulting and Coaching firm called Mitara Consulting Services.

She is an Erickson Certified Coach and has been a speaker for the National Association of Software and Service Companies and National Institute of Personnel Management forums. Moreover, a strong believer in the power of storytelling, she owns a franchise of Storytrails in Trivandrum called Kalapraस्था.

Ms. Aditi gave an insight on how to build yourselves as a brand and how pertinent it is to adjust and showcase your brand. She elucidated about the four important components of a brand, and also about the reflected best self-

exercise, which helps an individual to develop a sense of their “personal best” in order to increase their future potential.

She also emphasized on the importance of having a role model, to become the best version of ourselves and also gave prominence to sharpening our skills and continuously building our brand, and also stressed that marketing is a necessary skill.
