ASAP LAUNCHES IT INDUSTRY COURSE WITH SCHOLARSHIPS - MBCET STUDENTS TAKE LEAD

In a significant initiative to nurture young talent and promote IT education, the Additional Skill Acquisition Programme (ASAP) launched a comprehensive course on the IT industry, commencing on 29th May 2025.

The curriculum offers a holistic blend of learning, covering programming fundamentals, web development (front-end and back-end), database management, emerging technological trends, software development life cycles, project management tools, version control systems, and the basics of cybersecurity.

The programme is supported by a 75% scholarship funded by the Rotary Club, benefitting 30 students. Notably, 25 of these students are from Mar Baselios College of Engineering and Technology (MBCET), reflecting the institution's strong focus on skill development and academic excellence.

Delivered in a hybrid mode, the course combines the flexibility of remote learning with the benefits of in-person mentorship and peer collaboration, ensuring both accessibility and quality of instruction.


