began on 07 November 2025, and will continue through 07 November 2026. The celebrations include mass singing of the song, commemorative stamps and coins, and various cultural events organized across the country. The initiative aims to honour the song's legacy as a rallying cry for India's freedom movement and to connect citizens, especially the youth, with its patriotic spirit. Vande Mataram written by Bankim Chandra Chatterjee in 1875, first appeared in his novel Anandamath and was published in the literary journal Bangadarshan. It became a powerful rallying cry during the Indian independence movement, fostering patriotism and national pride, and was adopted as the national song by the Constituent Assembly in 1950. Bankim Chandra Chatterjee was an Indian Bengali novelist, poet, essayist and journalist. He is considered a pioneer of modern Bengali literature, and his novels are rich in patriotic emotion.
